- The Spring Equinox was at 05:20 (Jerusalem Time) on 20 March
- 1st Visible Crescent after sunset (17:48 Jerusalem Time) was on 31 March
- The Israelis probably set aside their 1st Passover lambs on 1*10
- “Three Days Of Darkness” were probably 1*11-13
- The 1st Passover Lambs were killed on the afternoon of 1*14
- The 1st Passover Meal was eaten on the evening that started 1*15
- The Destroyer passed through Egypt in the middle of the night on 1*15
- The Israelis left Egypt while the Egyptians were burying their dead on 1*15
- Israel may have spent the 16th as their first Sabbath rest at Sukkoth
- Once in the Promised Land, the 1st Day of the Week following the Sabbath of Unleavened Bread would be declared “Feast of First Fruits,” when the first sheaf of the barley harvest was cut & presented to God. It was Day One of a 50-Day count to “Pentecost” & the start of the wheat harvest.
- “The Feast of Unleavened Bread” may have been a commemoration of Israel’s first week of travel upon leaving Egypt
- Israel may have crossed the Red Sea during the overnight hours of 1*22
- Israel may have spent the 23rd as their second Sabbath rest

- The Spring Equinox was at 13:01 (Jerusalem Time) on 19 March
- 1st Visible Crescent after sunset (17:49 Jerusalem Time) was on 20 March
- Jesus entered Jerusalem as the Final Passover lamb on 1*10
- Jesus spent 1*11-13 teaching in the Temple to spiritually darkened hearts
- Jesus ate the Passover meal with His apostles on the evening that began 1*14
- Jesus died as the Final Passover Lambs on the afternoon of 1*14
- Jesus was buried before the High Sabbath began at the sunset that began 1*15
- There was a day of rest & reflection on 1*15
- Jesus rose from the dead on 1*16 as the “First Fruits” of those permanently resurrected from the dead. 50 days later, a great harvest of souls would begin with the birth of the Church
