The “Perfect Pattern” for setting “Pentecost” was accomplished by counting seven full weeks following the Sabbath Day observed during the Feast of Unleavened Bread.

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- 1st Visible Crescent after sunset (19:22 Jerusalem Time) was on 29 May
- The Israelis probably arrived at Mt. Sinai on 3*2, Day 45 of the 50-Day Count to “Pentecost” because 1*1 was a New Moon holiday & a day off from work
- God probably ordered Moses to carry out the three-day-prep of the people for their first “Pentecost” starting on 1*4 (Exodus 19:10-11)
- God apparently spoke “The Ten Commandments” to Israel on “Pentecost”
- Once in the Promised Land, the wheat harvest could not begin until the day after Pentecost, which was a holiday & a day off from work

- The Apostles, having witnessed the Ascension of Jesus from the Mount of Olives on Day 40 of the 50-Day Count to “Pentecost,” spent the next ten days waiting at Jerusalem as commanded
- The daylight hours of “Pentecost” in AD 33 fell on SUN 24 May
- The supernatural impartation of the Holy Spirit came at the “ninth hour,” which was the hour of morning incense, prayer & sacrifice, when the Apostles would have been at the Temple Mount with hundreds of thousands of Jews commemorating the Mount Sinai Covenant, when God spoke out His Word
- THUS, the “New Covenant” was proclaimed on “Pentecost” from Mount Zion, while the “Old Covenant” was proclaimed on “Pentecost” from Mount Sinai
- The N.T. “harvest of souls” began on “Pentecost” AD 33
