"I said to him, "My lord, you know." And he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. For this reason, they are before the throne of God; and they serve Him day and night in His temple; and He who sits on the throne will spread His tabernacle over them." (Revelation 7:14-15)

"And he [the Beast Leader] opened his mouth in blasphemies against God, to blaspheme His name and His tabernacle, that is, those who dwell in heaven." (Revelation 13:6)

"Then there was given me a measuring rod like a staff; and someone said, "Get up and measure <u>the temple of God and the altar, and those who worship in it</u>. "Leave out <u>the court which is outside the temple</u> and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread under foot <u>the holy</u> city for forty-two months." (Revelation 11:1-2)

"And <u>another angel came out of the temple</u>, crying out with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, "Put in your sickle and reap, for the hour to reap has come, because the harvest of the earth is ripe." Then He who sat on the cloud swung His sickle over the earth, and the earth was reaped. And <u>another angel</u> came out of the temple which is in heaven, and he also had a sharp sickle."
